New Features LinkOne Offline Capability

Epic Number LO-20

This LinkOne WebView release includes the introduction of the WebView Offline client. The purpose of this client is to provide users the ability to download a limited subset of book content to view when the browser is in the offline state, with key functionality being provided. While in the offline state, users can select parts which can then be processed when the browser is back online. The Offline client is not a full replacement for the full functionality of the Online client.

The Offline client displays each image using a single static image, utilising the browser's capability to provide magnification. This may result in some minor image resolution deficiencies in the Offline client compared to the Online client.

Information on browser compatibility can be found in the LinkOne WebView Getting Started Guide and LinkOne WebView Technical Reference Guide.

A wide set of book content and images have been used in testing the Offline client. We appreciate your feedback on using the Offline Client, LinkOne WebView in general along with the other LinkOne products. Problem

Layout/Formats using ROWGAP and ENTRYGAP attributes, particularly with percentage values result in larger than expected gaps

Solution

Between WebView 3.24 and 3.25 releases, a code change was made that flowed through and enabled the ROWGAP and ENTRY GAP functionality, that previously had been inactive. As a result of receiving this case, it has been found that there was also a calculation error when Percentage based values for these attributes was used. The code has been adjusted appropriately.
